Gather:

- Take some time to talk about your week.

Change:

- Read James 7-12. Brad talked about ways of being actively generous. In what area do you need to take a step of growth? Why? How will you take that step?
 1. Be patient
 2. Build Endurance
 3. Be Consistent
 4. Show Compassion
- **Be Bold!** Read James 5:16. Break into even smaller groups or couples and do this. Confess and Pray for each other. Don't just hear, don't just read, but rather do!
