### Change:

- Think back to the message and share what theme, verse, or point stuck out the most? Why? \*\*\*Remember to bring your Update from the weekend to refresh your memory.
- Brad said that Paul, the author of the letter to Rome, uses four words to summarize everything to that point: **God is for us**. Is that something you have ever thought about or heard taught before? Do those 4 words change anything for you?
- Read Romans 8:31. What does that actually mean?
- Read Romans 8:32-34. What really stands out to you? What’s your biggest take-a-way from these verses.
- Brad used the analogy of being in a courtroom as a defendant and being overwhelmingly guilty. But because of what Jesus did on a cross you are found innocent. **This is not fair. This is undeserved. This is all because God is for you.** Discuss the impact on your life of that idea.
- Read Romans 8:35-37. This is where the title of the series comes from; #NothingWill. How can we be “victorious through him” in all of the things Paul lists? What makes that possible? If you’re not living in that, what steps can you make to start?
- What else has God put on your heart to share with the group? This can be about this week’s teaching or anything else going on in your life. Now is the time to share with those who care about you and love you.
